As of the First of March 2018, some 40 countries and 73,000 individuals and businesses have formally joined the campaign. Governments have declared their support to its overall goals and taking specific commitments including but not limited to:

- Establish National and Regional Marine Litter Action Plans.
- Pioneer national legislation and policies to promote marine litter reduction.
- Implement market and non-market based instruments and incentives to encourage industry and private sector to take more action towards combatting marine litter.
- Set up national plastic management systems to measure their total plastic footprint.

Faith based groups, businesses and others can take voluntary action to reduce their use of plastic in their supply chain, design and consumer-facing products. With their collaboration, we hope we can inspire citizens to act, governments to follow and a new generation of corporate leaders to step forward and act.
